Private Sewer Lines

On February 8, 2007, City Council passed an ordinance amending Chapter 42, Article II of the Code of Ordinances pertaining to maintenance of private sewer lines. Like the previous ordinance, the new ordinance requires repair of private sewer lines (the sewer line between the home and the public sewer line) that admit earth or water or permit the escape of effluents (Inflow/Infiltration or I&I). However, the new ordinance requires that repairs be completed within 365 days, instead of the previous maximum of 180 days, after receiving notice from the City. Sewer line inspections commenced in June 2007. Letters have been and are being sent to owners notifying them of needed repairs, as inspections continue neighborhood by neighborhood. The City is extending billing the \$25 surcharge until September 2008, for customers that received letters in June, July, and August 2007; as long as the required repairs are completed and inspected by September 1, 2008. Owners of rental property will be prohibited from renting property to a new tenant until the repairs have been completed. Persons of low-income may be eligible for financial assistance through the Community Development Block Grant program and can obtain further information by calling (281) 420-5396.
