**Preface**

Purchasing has obtained ICMA Consulting Services (International City / County Management Association) to assist in the development and identification of necessary criteria to be used for a potential RFP for EMS emergency and non-emergency transport service.

ICMA has not been solicited to write the RFP, but only to provide important criteria that will be used to identify possible options. City Council is looking at available options for the provision of EMS transport services.
