Project: Housing/Housing Rehabilitation
Location: Within the city limits of Baytown
Funding: \$409,983
Description: Repairs to owner-occupied homes of low-income persons.

Project: Housing/Homebuyers' Assistance Program
Location: Within the city limits of Baytown
Funding: \$103,691
Description: Closing cost assistance for eligible low to moderate-income homebuyers.

Project: Housing/Residential Sewer Line Repair/Replace
Location: Within the city limits of Baytown
Funding: \$21,600
Description: Repairs to yard sewer lines of low to moderate-income homeowners.

Project: Property Clearance/Substandard Structures Abatement
Location: Within the city limits of Baytown
Funding: \$156,233
Description: Demolition or securing of dilapidated, abandoned buildings.

Project: Property Clearance/Baytown Habitat for Humanity
Location: 2018 Georgia Street
Funding: \$20,000
Description: Clear land and dilapidated structure to use for low-income housing.

Project: Public Facilities/Public Works
Location: In CDBG target areas
Funding: \$40,623
Description: Sidewalk, alleyway, and curb repair or replacement in CDBG target areas.
