June 7-11

Flower Power (grades 5-8)

Roses are red, Violets are blue. Join us for camp and collect a flower or two! Learn the common and scientific names, anatomy, habitat and soil needs of many plants that grow in Baytown. Collect, identify and press your own flower collection.

June 14-18

Birding Bonanza (grades 4-6)

Look in the sky! What is that flying? Use binoculars and field guides to observe birds in their natural habitat. Learn bird biology, habitat, migration patterns and much more while having fun outdoors!

June 21-24

Nature's Canvas (grades 6-10)

Let nature be the guide as campers create art using various methods during this week for aspiring artists. Field trips to local art venues and wetlands ecosystems bring out the natural artist in every camper.

June 28-July 2

Southern Trailblazers (grades 3-5)
