City Parks - Over the past decade, the City of Baytown has invested much effort into creating and revitalizing its local parks. The town boasts more than 40 parks, with a variety of amenities. Many of these parks are situated on or near Goose Creek. Before its restoration, this neglected waterway was often used as a dumping ground. Now, thanks to the Goose Creek Stream Project, nearly 7 miles of bicycle-pedestrian trails have been constructed along its banks.

The public parks in the City of Baytown are open daily all year round from 5 a.m. to 10 p.m. There are no entrance fees, with the exception of the Baytown Nature Center.

Senior & Disabled Transportation Programs



The Senior and Disabled Transportation Program provides non-emergency transportation services to eligible, low income, senior and/or disabled citizens within the city limits of Baytown, and to and from Houston for medical appointments. Participants are required to prove eligibility and must apply in person at the Community Development Office.

If eligible, a participant will be issued a ride card for the taxicab in Baytown, and access to ride coupons for the Harris County Rides Program. The taxi ride card affords the participant two (2) one-way taxicab rides per month, not to exceed \$8.00. Each participant must pay any portion of the fare over \$8.00. Red Top Cab Company, Pasadena Taxi Inc., N Finity Transportation, and Baytown Express Taxi are the four (4) participating taxicab companies for demand response service in Baytown. The American Red Cross, N Finity Transportation, and Reliant Transit Services provide the shared ride service, with 24 hour advance notice around Baytown, and to Houston for medical appointments.
