City of Baytown Proposed Funding Application

On or about July 31, 2009, the City of Baytown will submit a funding application to the Office of Rural Community Affairs (ORCA) for the 2008 Supplemental Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Disaster Recovery Program for Non-Housing Activities. Funding is made available by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for eligible non-housing, infrastructure, and economic development activities resulting from both Hurricane Ike and Dolly. Eligible non-housing, public infrastructure projects include buildings, drainage, transportation, and water/wastewater that was either damaged or failed to function as a result of Hurricane Ike or Dolly. This notice is provided to inform the public of the City's intent to apply for grant funds.
