The City of Baytown must complete a 5-year Consolidated Plan that establishes the needs and priorities for low to-moderate income persons and areas of Baytown. The Consolidated Plan also determines how the City will use nearly \$5 million dollars in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for the next 5 years. This Plan is mandated by the Federal agency HUD to address housing, social services, infrastructure, and community revitalization needs in Baytown. We want as much input from Baytown residents, companies and service agencies as possible so that the plan we develop will be YOUR assessment of the needs in Baytown and YOUR priorities for addressing the needs with CDBG money.
