Baytown residents living in Harris County can take advantage of early voting in the Mockingbird Room of the Baytown Community Center, 2407 Market Street, October 19 – 30.

- Monday through Friday, October 19 – 23 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Saturday, October 24 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Sunday, October 25 from 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Monday through Friday, October 26 – 30, 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Early voting for Baytown residents living in Chambers County, will be conducted at the Chambers County Courthouse, 404 Washington Avenue, Anahuac, October 19 – 30. (7 a.m. to 7 p.m.)

An early voting branch for Chambers County will open up at the Cedar Bayou Annex, Justice of the Peace, Precinct No. 6 Courtroom, located in the Cedar Bayou Community Building, 7711 Highway 146 from October 26 – 30 (7 a.m. to 7 p.m.)

Items on the ballot that Baytown residents can vote on are the Texas Constitutional Amendments (11 propositions); details on these propositions can be viewed here (link to PDF).
