Public Service Announcement: Fair Housing, It's the Law

To promote fair housing practices, the City of Baytown encourages potential homeowners and renters to be aware of their rights under the National Fair Housing Law. Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, as amended, prohibits discrimination against any person on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, disability, familial status or national origin in the sale or rental of units in the housing market. Policy of Nondiscrimination on the Basis of Disability

The City of Baytown does not discriminate on the basis of disability in the admission or access to, or employment in, its federally assisted programs or activities. The Civil Rights Officer has been designated to coordinate compliance with the nondiscrimination requirements contained in the Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) regulations implementing Section 504 (24 CFR Part 8).

Citizen Participation & Grievance Procedures Notice

The City of Baytown has adopted complaint and grievance procedures regarding its Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-MIT). Citizens may obtain a copy of these written procedures at PO BOX 424, Baytown, TX, 77522-0424 during regular business hours. Citizens may also request the procedures be mailed to them by calling the Civil Rights Officer at (281) 420-6522. These procedures outline the steps for a citizen to follow if s/he wishes to file a complaint or grievance about CDBG-MIT activities.

A person who has a complaint or grievance about any services or activities with respect to the CDBG-MIT project, may during regular business hours submit such complaint or grievance, in writing to at PO BOX 424, Baytown TX 77522-0424 or may call (281) 420-6522. The City of Baytown will make every effort to respond fully to such complaints within fifteen (15) working days where practicable.

Notice to Section 3 Residents and Business Interests

The City of Baytown has received Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery (CDBG-MIT) funding for a construction project. The City of Baytown invites individuals and businesses to certify themselves as Section 3 eligible by registering with the Section 3 Coordinator, Sharon Rose. Section 3 Residents must reside in a Public Housing unit, or be a low or very-low income person residing in the area of CDBG-MIT funded project and be interested in seeking employment on CDBG-MIT funded projects. Businesses may be designated as Section 3 eligible if 51% or more of the business is owned by Section 3 Residents, at least 30% of permanent, full-time employees are or have been Section 3 Residents in the past 3 years, or if business commits to subcontract in excess of 25% of dollar award of all subcontracts to

Section 3 business concern. The City of Baytown shall notify registered Section 3 Residents and Business Interests of employment and contracting opportunities related to the CDBG-MIT funded projects. Registration and information are available at the City of Baytown, PO BOX 424, Baytown, TX 77522-0424 or by calling (281) 420-5390.
