

Consider an ordinance granting a pipeline permit to HSC Pipeline Partnership, LLC. for one 16-inch ethylene pipeline.

PREFACE

This proposed ordinance approves a new pipeline and permit for HSC Pipeline Partnership, LLC, to install a 16-inch ethylene pipeline. The pipeline will cross Tri-Cities Beach Road, with a route through Industrial District #3, in a north-easterly direction, towards Mont Belvieu. A site map showing the pipeline is attached for you review.

The proposed pipeline is an intrastate pipeline regulated by intrastate rules/regulations and will transport ethane, with a maximum operating pressure of 2160 PSIG. The carrier pipe will have an outside diameter of 16-inches, a wall thickness of 0.500-inches and be made of API 5Lx60 carbon steel pipe with a MILS FBE coating.

Staff recommends a construction bond of \$100,000.00 in order to cover the cost of any damages caused by the pipeline company to public assets.
