

## Acceptable IDs

City of Baytown Vital Statistics accepts the following form(s) of identification (ID)\*:

1. Provide **ONE (1)** Item from **GROUP A**; OR
2. If you do not have one from Group A, Provide **TWO (2)** Items from **GROUP B**; OR
3. If you do not have one from Group A or two from Group B, provide **ONE (1)** from **GROUP B** and **TWO (2)** from **GROUP C**.

### Group A - PRIMARY ACCEPTABLE ID - Please provide **ONE (1)** from **GROUP A**:

**Note:** The applicant's identification must contain the applicant's name and photograph that establishes the applicant's identity. [TAC 181.28(i)(10)(C)]

- Driver's License; Pilot's license
- Federal or State Identification card; SENTRI Card; U.S. Citizen Identification Card
- Law enforcement employment ID (federal, state, or city)
- Offender ID issued by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice or an ID from a federal or U.S. State correctional facility or institution
- Military Identification card
- Concealed Handgun License
- United States Passport
- Department of Homeland Security, United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) issued:
  - Employment Authorization Document (EAD)
  - Permanent Resident Card (Green card)
  - *Travel Documents:*
    - Re-entry Permit
    - Refugee Travel Permit or
    - Advance Parole
- *United States Department of State issued:*
  - Visa or Border Crossing Card (BCC) - B1 for business or pleasure or B2 medical purposes

### Group B - SECONDARY ACCEPTABLE ID - Please provide **TWO (2)** of **GROUP B**:

**Note:** At least one of the documents must contain the applicant's name, signature, or identifiable photo of the applicant. [TAC 181.28(i)(11)(C)]

- Current student identification
- Any Primary Identification that is expired (**no more than 3 years**)
- Signed Social Security card or Numident (**not Laminated**)
- DD Form 214 Certificate of Release
- Medicaid, Medicare, Veterans Affairs, or Health insurance card
- Foreign Passport accompanied by a Visa issued by the United States Department of State
- Foreign Passport in accordance with the United States Department of State, Visa Waiver Program
- Certified birth certificate from the US Department of State (FS-240, DS-1350 or FS-545)
- Private Company Employment ID card
- Form I-94 - accompanied by the applicant's Visa or Passport;
- Mexican voter registration card
- Foreign Identification with identifiable photo of applicant (including El Salvador Consular Certificate, El Salvadoran Unique ID Card (DUI), and Honduran Consular certification)

### Group C – SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS - Please provide **ONE (1)** From **GROUP B** and **TWO (2)** from **GROUP C**:

- Recent Utility bill, Rent receipt, Cell phone bill or Lease agreement with current address
- Recent Paycheck stub
- Public assistance applications or letters
- Signed valid voter's registration card
- Official School transcript
- Bank account statement
- Social security letter
- Marriage license or Divorce decree
- Certified birth certificate from a state other than Texas, District of Columbia or other country
- Automobile insurance card, title or registration
- Court order
- Library card, Fishing or hunting license
- Recent Medical records and bills
- Religious records w/signature of religious official
- Federal, state, or local tax records
