

NOTICE OF 2019 TAX YEAR PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR CITY OF BAYTOWN

A tax rate of \$0.80203 per \$100 valuation has been proposed for adoption by the governing body of City of Baytown. This rate exceeds the lower of the effective or rollback tax rate, and state law requires that two public hearings be held by the governing body before adopting the proposed tax rate.

The governing body of City of Baytown proposes to use revenue attributable to the tax rate increase for the purpose of providing for the maintenance and operations required to provide municipal services to the citizens of the City of Baytown, including the servicing of municipal debt.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.80203 per \$100
PRECEDING YEAR'S TAX RATE	\$0.81203 per \$100
EFFECTIVE TAX RATE	\$0.76139 per \$100
ROLLBACK TAX RATE	\$0.80447 per \$100

The effective tax rate is the total tax rate needed to raise the same amount of property tax revenue for City of Baytown from the same properties in both the 2018 tax year and the 2019 tax year.

The rollback tax rate is the highest tax rate that City of Baytown may adopt before voters are entitled to petition for an election to limit the rate that may be approved to the rollback rate.
