Parents/Guardians and the Goose Creek Community,

The safety and security of our students is always our top priority. As such, it is important that we occasionally hold drills to prepare for a variety of incidents. These drills help us make improvements to our response to an unplanned event on one of our campuses.

Goose Creek CISD has scheduled several "lockdown drills" for Wed., Jan. 6, Thurs., Jan 7 and Fri., Jan. 8. On those days, a lockdown drill will be conducted on two campuses. These drills will begin in the morning and be completed by early afternoon. No one will be allowed to enter or exit a campus once that campus's lockdown drill has begun. Not all campuses will participate in this round of lockdown drills, but they will all be prepared to do so. The campuses selected for drills will not be notified that they have been selected until the Drill Evaluation Team arrives to begin the simulated scenario.

These scheduled drills will be held in conjunction with the GCCISD Administration, GCCISD Police Department, Baytown Police Department and the Baytown Fire Department. These drills, as well as monthly fire drills and twice-yearly tornado drills, are routinely scheduled throughout the school year to ensure the safety and security of all our students, faculty and staff.

Please do not be alarmed if you see local district and police and fire department vehicles on a GCCISD campus on the dates listed above. With the exception of the lockdown drills, we will have a regular school day. Thank you for your understanding. Please call the central Administration office if you have any questions.
