

POLICE EMERGENCY DRIVING

Course #2046

Police Emergency driving course is a four-day (32 hour) program designed to train Police Officers to properly handle a vehicle during emergency driving situations. The course is a realistic, high-stress, competency based; task related driving school that gives the student about 24 hours of actual driving time.

The course addresses the following areas:

- **Civil and Criminal liabilities in emergency vehicle operations.**
- **The mechanics of driver control and proper driver attitude.**
- **Vehicle dynamics.**
- **Skid control.**
- **Various proficiency exercises require qualification**

Materials to bring: Participants should bring a police vehicle outfitted with heavy-duty police suspension. Vehicle must be in sound mechanical condition, capable of passing a safety inspection. The course will be stressful on vehicle tires and therefore a good set of tires should be used, severely worn tires will be considered hazardous and will not be permitted on the course.

1st Day Course Location students will need to report to the Baytown Police Academy located at 203 E. Wye Drive, Baytown, Texas 77521 (8am-5pm)

2nd, 3rd (Late Day) & 4th Day Course Location will be held at the Humble Civic Center located at 8233 Will Clayton Pkwy, Humble, TX 77338
