

POLICE ATV SAFETY & TACTICS
Course # 2045

This course is designed to familiarize officers in the use of 4 wheel ATV's for special patrol duties. This course will teach officers how to handle the ATV on highway conditions as well as tactical off-road use of the ATV. The course incorporates dismounting of the vehicle under stress, drawing and firing your duty weapon and off-road pursuit tactics. This course incorporates riding in pairs, as well as dismounts and tactical approaches. Students will learn how to properly use their ATV's for cover and concealment. Students will also participate in grid searches over various types of terrain. Course will include the AT-VSI Curriculum. Baytown PD will furnish the ATV's for use in the class. **If you desire to bring your own, contact should be made with instructors prior to the class.** Students will need:

- His / her duty gear;
- Duty weapon(s) and 250 rounds of duty ammunition;
- Long pants and long sleeve shirts
- Eye protection;
- Gloves; and
- Over ankle boots
- **Body Armor (which is mandatory).**

Students may provide their own DOT approved helmets. Class size is limited to **8 students (No Exceptions)**. **The first day the students will meet at the Baytown Police Academy located at 203 E. Wye Drive.** The second and third day will be held at the Baytown Police Range located at 3703 McLean Road, Baytown, Texas 77521

Class hours are 8:00am – 5:00pm.
