CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT

NUMBER OF MEMBERS:	Seven (7)
APPOINTED BY:	City Council
COMPOSED OF:	Seven (7) citizens committed to crime control and prevention in the City of Baytown. Each member of the City Council appoints a Crime Control and Prevention District Member, who does not have to be a resident of the Council member's district.
TERM OF OFFICE:	Members serve staggered two-year terms. Initial members will draw lots to stagger their terms. Three directors will serve terms expiring September 1, 2007, and four directors will serve terms expiring September 1, 2008. Vacancies will be filled for the unexpired term of office in the same manner that the original appointment was made.
MEETINGS:	As needed.
DUTIES:	To maintain and implement new initiatives to continue the reduction in the crime rate and enhancing public safety without a substantial increase in the ad valorem tax rate.
APPROVED:	By the voters on May 13, 2006.
ORDINANCE NO.:	10,336, passed and approved May 22, 2006
