Service	Impact Fee per Equivalent Dwelling Unit (EDU)
Water	\$1,087
Wastewater	<u>\$2,437</u>
Impact Fee per EDU	\$3,524

To determine the total impact fee that may apply to your project you must use the below formula by selecting the type of meter needed to calculate the total impact fee due for each EDU.

EDU = Equivalent Development Unit = 5/8" Meter

Formula (Ratio to 5/8" Meter x Impact Fee per EDU = Total Impact Fee for each EDU)
